### COMPETITION CONDITIONS

1. Entry fees must be paid at time of entry, otherwise they will be rejected.
2. Competitors will be made Honorary Members of the Clifton Springs Golf Club for the day.
3. Eligible players are male and female amateurs whose Australian Handicap at the time of entry does not exceed 36 (male) and 45 (female) in accordance with the Australian Handicapping System.
4. Players must be prepared to play when called upon to do so by the Committee.
5. Entries are restricted to Amateurs who are members of Clubs of Golf Victoria, or of Golf Clubs registered with such State or Overseas Association as are affiliated with or recognised by this Association, or of Clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League, and the Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
6. Competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, together with such Local Rules as are in force on the course over which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Committee in charge of the Competition.
7. Protests must be made to the Event Committee not later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of each round. The decision of the Event Committee will be final in all matters relating to the event.
8. The Committee may, in the event of bad weather, or for any reason, either cancel or shorten any contest.
9. The Committee shall have the power to limit the number of entries which are received for any event and to alter the time for starting any event, as indicated in this programme.
10. In the event of ties in handicap events they will be decided by a count - back as recommended by Golf Australia..
11. No player may receive more than 1 major trophy. (Not including Teams Events.)
12. No refunds will be given in the event of player's inability to participate.
