



Fog Policy

General Statement of Policy:

This policy has been developed to ensure the safety of golfers and staff. The following guidelines are to be implemented when a heavy fog is imminent or present on the golf course limiting player and staff visibility.

1. The Pro Shop, any member of Match Committee or a designated Staff Member, is responsible for implementing this policy.
2. Play shall not commence and / or shall be suspended if the white marker on the North side of the 4th fairway cannot be seen from the corner of the pro-shop.
3. Players on the course will be advised of the decision via one long siren blow, which will be undertaken by the Pro Shop, any member of Match Committee or a designated Staff Member.
4. Signage advising that play cannot commence or has been suspended will be placed outside the Pro Shop and on the 1st and 10th Tees.
5. The Pro Shop, a member of Match Committee or a designated Staff Member, will continually assess conditions.
6. The decision to re-commence play will be made by the Pro Shop, a member of Match Committee or a designated Staff Member, and golfers advised via two long sirens blows.
7. On the resumption of play, players are to ensure the groups in front are not within hitting range before playing.
8. Play will commence or resume at booked tee-times. Members who have missed their tee time because of the fog will need to re-book.
9. The Pro Shop, a member of Match Committee or a designated Staff Member shall advise Club Management and Course Superintendent or his representative of the decision to delay, suspend and / or cancel play.
